UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

I. March 17, 2022: 26th CityNet Japan Forum: First responder training through C2C Cooperation

This annual program is scheduled to be held in as a hybrid event presented by Makati and Yokohama. All CityNet members will be invited to join online. Further details regarding the programme and registration will be announced on the CityNet Yokohama Project Office website in February.

II. Starting April 1, 2022: Disaster Prevention Education and Material Development Project

Expansion of the Disaster Prevention Education and Material Development Project in Nepal is expected to resume starting in June. Funded by the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), this three-year project will be completed in three phases. Between 2017 and 2019, 18 schools from 5 municipalities in the Kathmandu Valley participated in the program. Further details will be shared in due course.

III. May 25 - 27, 2022: Global Platform for DRR

The CityNet Disaster Cluster is planning its annual seminar to coincide with the UNDRR Global Platform for Disaster Risk Reduction (GPDRR2022) to be held in Bali, Indonesia, from May 25-27, 2022. Both onsite and hybrid formats are being considered, in light of the ongoing global circumstances. Further details will be announced in the months leading up to the conference. The event is pending approval from the UNDRR.
